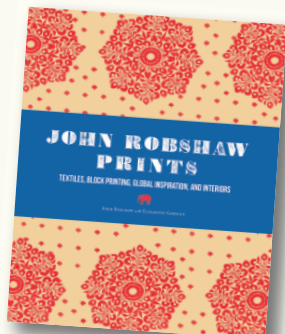

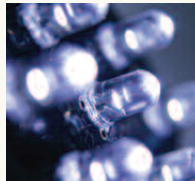

Mac Whitney's abstract sculptures, constructed out of raw steel, are a metaphysical expression of the fundamental forces of tension and resolution evident in the built environment: the thrust of a tall vertical; the repose of an outstretched horizontal; the dynamism of a forceful diagonal; the lyricism of a slowly unfolding curve – all subtly knit into the fabric of a freestanding form that is both open and closed. The works on view are from Whitney's most recent *Linked Sculpture* Series. Recalling interweaving DNA or molecules, these sculptures are composed like an interlocking chain of various shapes before welded upright into a vertical sculpture.

Mac Whitney's work has been exhibited nationally and internationally over the last 40 years, and is part of many public collections including the Dallas Museum of Art and Art Museum of South Texas Corpus Christi.
